

Year 9 RPE (Religion, Philosophy and Ethics) Homework

Some of the tasks require you to learn the key information from the knowledge organisers that you have been given. You are expected to know all of the information from each of these knowledge organisers. You will find the knowledge organisers in your RPE Teams channel titled, 'Knowledge Organisers'.

Some homework tasks include an online quiz to help you to test your knowledge. You can find the links to the quizzes in your class Team.

There are also some homework tasks that requires you to watch a video clip and answer questions and a few tasks that will ask for your views and opinions on certain matters.

Revision strategies

There are lots of ways in which you could revise the key information, especially when you are required to learn key information from knowledge organisers. Here are some examples:

- Make flashcards with key questions and answers on them and get a member of your family or a friend to test you on them.
- Create a mind map of each topic, using the knowledge organiser to help you.
- Look at your mind map, then put it away and try to reproduce it on a blank sheet of paper or in your RPE exercise book.
- Create a 'keyword' sheet by writing up key **bold** words from the knowledge organiser and then drawing something next to it to help you remember what it means.
- Make yourself a Quizlet or a Kahoot based on the information in the knowledge organiser and play it with your friends.

It is a good idea to try different revision techniques through the year so that you can find out what works best for you.

Year 9 RPE Homework Task 14

This homework task will help you prepare for the upcoming assessment.

Next lesson, you will be sitting an assessment to complete a 9-mark extended piece of writing (essay).

You will complete this next lesson. The question (statement) has already been given to you and you need to start thinking about what you will write. You must evaluate the statement, which means look at both sides of the argument and write about the strengths and/or weaknesses for each argument.

This homework task will help you discover opportunities on how to make the world a better place.

We have seen how racism can have a detrimental impact in society and how love and care for one another and treating people equally can have a very positive impact.

Your homework is to research 3 different careers a person can go into to **promote a positive change in the world**. Write out the title of the job, what it entails and what experiences or qualifications are required. You can search on Unifrog or Google to help you.

For example, working for Oxfam, a charity organisation. This job may entail fundraising, collecting clothes, food and donations and delivering it to people who are in unfortunate to help resolve poverty. To work or volunteer for Oxfam you may need good communication skills and have confidence in public speaking.

Write out the information in your exercise book and then take a picture of your work and upload it on the homework assignment on Teams.

Year 9 RPE Homework Task 16

This homework task is your opportunity to revisit your views and opinions on the topic we have been studying, racism and see if any of your views have changed.

Complete the post-unit questionnaire about racism. There are no right or wrong answers - you just need to give your honest opinion. No other students will see your answer.
